

ETCHED WINDOW REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

The City recently implemented an “Etched Window Reimbursement Program” which provides partial reimbursement to property/business owners for the costs incurred to replace storefront windows damaged by etching acid and/or etching tools.

At this time, this Program only applies to businesses that are located within the following boundaries:

Second Street and Mission Blvd. from Park to Gibbs
Garey Avenue from Holt Blvd. to Arrow Highway
Holt Blvd. from Garey Avenue to Indian Hill.

Etching acid eats into the glass and if it is not removed quickly will cause permanent damage. This can be a very expensive loss for a business owner especially since the vandals typically damage more than one window.

Since this is a reimbursement program, qualified applicants first must replace all damaged windows and have anti-graffiti film applied. The City will then reimburse fifty percent of the costs incurred up to a maximum of \$2,000. Funding is limited and reimbursements will be issued based on availability.
